Gospel: Luke 24.13-35 — The Road to Emmaus

Sharing our Burning Hearts

In today's Gospel we reflect on the Road to Emmaus. As the two disciples walk along, Jesus appears and breaks open the scriptures and breaks bread with them. This same structure is what we experience at Mass with the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Reflecting on their walk with Christ, the disciples were profoundly touched, exclaiming "were not our hearts burning within us?" So too, when we partake in Mass our hearts should burn within us from the glory and love of God. But what should we do with this burning?

The disciples rushed back to the others in Jerusalem "that same hour" and proclaimed that the Lord is risen. They learned more about their faith and went in haste to share the good news and support the other believers. Likewise, after growing in our faith and being strengthened at Mass we should support the believers in our parish community by giving of our time and talent. As stewards of Christ we should not delay in sharing our gifts from God with others but seek to help immediately.

This Easter season, let us decide to renew our commitment to our parish by joining various ministries to help the good news of the resurrection be proclaimed. The Church needs us to be sharers of God's gifts. St Peter in his first letter says "as each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied grace" (1 Peter 4:10). Let us end by asking ourselves, how well do we cultivate our gifts and aid the spread of the Gospel?

St. Martin de Porres Virtual Mass Guidelines

- 1. Please enter the Zoom session 15 minutes before the Mass starts in order to leave time for the Zoom host to admit you.
- 2. Before you enter the Zoom session, please enter your 'Name or Family Name' so we know who is celebrating Mass with us. Most importantly, it is Fr. Anthony's wish that all Zoom participants identify themselves before joining our Zoom virtual Masses. It is also more personal than seeing your device name (e.g., iPhone, Galaxy, or something else).
- 3. Please turn off the ringer on your cell phone during Mass. This is especially important for Lectors, Responders, Musicians, and Cantors to remember.
- 4. Please note that all participants will be "muted" during Mass, to eliminate the background noise that may be heard; except for Fr. Anthony, Lectors, Responders, Musicians, and Cantors.
- 5. You have an option to turn your video on or off, by clicking "Start Video" or "Stop Video" during Mass. If you choose to "Start Video" or turn it on, please be mindful that your actions will be seen by all participants. If you have to step away for a few minutes, please choose "Stop Video" and you will not be seen by participants.
- 6. Once you're signed in to Zoom, you have a way to change the view you see on your device. To **focus only on Fr. Anthony, tap/click "Speaker View"**; to view the participants who have their video turned on, change the view to "Gallery View"; to view only the Speaker (e.g. Fr. Anthony throughout the Mass), change to Mini view.
- 7. If signal disruption and/or technical issues occur during Mass, please be patient while we attempt to rectify the problem. If you encounter problems on your end and get disconnected, you can always rejoin the Zoom session.

Remember to always place yourself in the presence of God and focus your attention on the Mass.
