The message of Pentecost is that we are not alone. God is with us on our journey to the kingdom. At the Last

Supper he promised that he would not leave his disciples desolate. He sent them the Holy Spirit on Pentecost Day. Neither will he abandon us. Today we ask God to come in our lives and to strengthen us with his Spirit so that we will be his voice where the sick need healing, the hungry need feeding the distressed need comforting.

"How do you know that the Holy Spirit is working within you?"...

Have you ever asked yourself whether or not the Spirit is at work in your life?

"Am I willing to abandon myself to the power of the Spirit within? We know that the Spirit dwells in us because we have Jesus' word in John 14: 17, "You know him, because he abides with you, and he will be with you." Sometimes we don't acknowledge the power of God's Spirit within us, and we don't rely on that Spirit's power and guidance in our day to day living.
