

Unlocking the Secret of Happiness

"Lord, it is good to give thanks to you." These are the words from the refrain of this Sunday's responsorial psalm. Thanksgiving is at the core of what it means to be a steward. We cannot offer our gifts to our parish communities if we don't first acknowledge and give thanks to God for giving us these gifts in the first place. Cardinal Collins in his Pastoral Letter on Stewardship* says that, "deep stewardship begins with gratitude and ends with accountability ... We recognize gratefully that everything in life is a gift of God." Not only does gratitude unlock a spirituality of stewardship, but it is also the first step in living a life of greater joy. The opposite of gratitude is indifference. Often times we are indifferent and unaware of all the great gifts in our lives. By adopting an intentional lens of gratitude we can begin to realize how blessed we truly are. St. Gianna Molla beautifully tells us that "the secret of happiness is to live moment by moment and to thank God for what He is sending us every day in His goodness." Wherever we are reading this reflection, let us take a moment to thank God for three things around us. We can express our gratitude for having a roof over our heads, food in our stomachs, or the joy of family and friends. Above all, we can always be thankful for the gift of God's love in our lives. As stewards, let us begin to adopt a spirituality of thanks-

giving and begin living more joyful lives.

• The Archdiocese has specifically assigned hospital priest chaplains who provide ministry in large acute care hospitals in the GTA.

• Our Archdiocesan hospital priest chaplains provide sacramental care as well as pastoral care, spiritual guidance and prayers at the bedside.

• Despite restrictions in some hospitals, priest chaplains continue to have access to hospitals.

• Given the current restrictions, many hospitals are not yet allowing the priest chaplains to make nonurgent visits using the list of registered Catholic patients. If a patient desires to see a priest, please ask the patient or family member to speak to the patient's nurse to make a request.

• Please do not wait for the last minute to request the attendance of a priest.

Given the large turnover of staff in the hospitals, if a patient or family is incorrectly informed that a priest is available please contact the hospital's Spiritual Care Department.
