

#### The Paschal Candle 2024

At the beginning of The Easter Vigil ceremony, the Paschal Candle representing the Light of Christ, is marked with a Cross, the Alpha & Omega (the beginning & the end) and inscribed with the numerals 2024. Five grains of incense are inserted into the candle, marking the wounds of Christ. The Paschal Candle is then lit from the new fire.

The Paschal Candle is lit for all masses in the Easter Season until May. Our 2024 Paschal Candle also has images of the Risen Christ and the Lamb of God above and below the Cross.
